Glen GoodKnight Memorial Scholarship Fund Policies and Procedures

1. The Fund will be managed by the Mythopoeic Society treasurer, who will write checks from it as required.
2. Completed applications should be submitted to the conference Papers Coordinator.
3. The Papers Coordinator, in consultation with the Mythopoeic Society Council of Stewards and the Conference Committee, will make the final award/s. Award/s will consist of membership in the conference or credit toward other conference expenses.
4. No more than half of the Fund will be issued in one year. Funds may be awarded to multiple applicants.
5. Preference will be given to persons presenting a paper or participating on a panel, though others are not automatically excluded from consideration.
6. Information about applying for the Fund will be made available on the Society's web site, and by mail to anyone submitting a paper proposal.
7. The deadline for applying for funds will be two weeks after the deadline for paper abstracts. Decisions on grants will be made within two (2) weeks of this deadline.
8. Applicants will be notified by email or mail if they have been awarded funds.
