

Mythcon Outstanding Student Presentation Award Application Form  
(Alexei Kondratiev Award) for Mythopoeic Society Online Midsummer Seminar, August 5-6, 2023

An application form must be submitted to the committee chair, Janet Brennan Croft, at [mythlore@mythsoc.org](mailto:mythlore@mythsoc.org), at least 30 days before the first day of Mythcon. (Deadline for 2023 is July 5th.)

The finished paper must be submitted electronically to the chair at least ten days before the first day of Mythcon. (Deadline for 2023 is July 25.)

The paper must follow *Mythlore* style guidelines and should be between 4000 and 8000 words long. Guidelines: [https://dc.swosu.edu/mythlore/style\\_sheet.pdf](https://dc.swosu.edu/mythlore/style_sheet.pdf)

Applicants must be accepted in or currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program at the time their abstract was submitted.

Applicants must attend the conference or online seminar and present the paper to qualify for the award. (If Mythcon is in hybrid format, presentation in online form WILL count.)

The paper must not have been previously published in a peer-reviewed scholarly journal.

The winner will receive a certificate, a one-year subscription to *Mythlore* in paper format, and half-off registration for the next Mythcon or online seminar they attend. They are also strongly encouraged to submit the paper to *Mythlore* for consideration, but publication is not guaranteed.

The winner will be announced at the Mythcon banquet (or online equivalent) and on the society's website, as well as in *Mythlore* and *Mythprint*.
